

Sangerfest 2010 Performances



The Overture Center for the Arts (www.overturecenter.com or 608-258-4141 for tickets) will be the venue for performances at Sangerfest 2010. This beautiful facility is located one block from the Wisconsin Capitol, and in the midst of the colorful State Street-University of Wisconsin–Madison shopping and dining district. Made possible by a large grant from Madison philanthropist W. Jerome Frautschi, the facility was designed by internationally renowned architect Cesar Pelli, and integrates newly constructed Overture Hall with nearby existing structures, including the refurbished Capitol Theater.

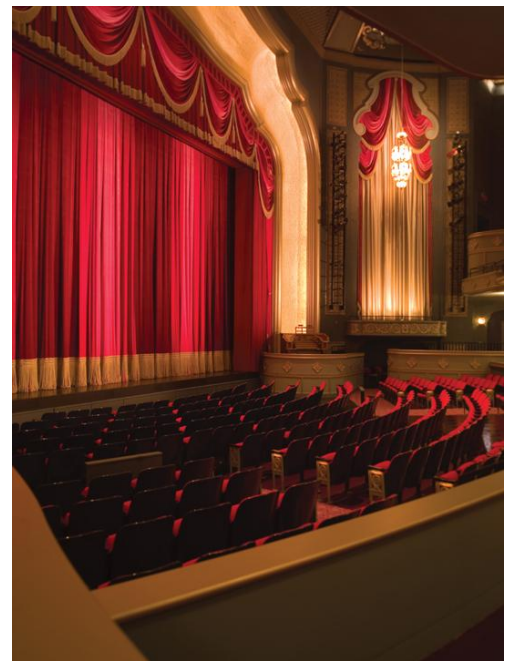

Grand Concert



Overture Hall, a modern state-of-the-art performance space, will be the site of the Grand Concert at 7:30 PM on Saturday, June 26th. For this concert, members of NSAA choruses will perform a program of selections including music by Norwegian and other Scandinavian composers and English language sacred and secular pieces.

The chorus will perform accompanied by piano and by The Wisconsin Chamber Orchestra. Soloists soprano Sarah Lawrence and tenor-baritone Calland Metts will perform as part of the concert, and will join the chorus and orchestra for some selections.

Conductors will be Dr. David Judisch, Director in Chief of NSAA; Edwin Kramer, Assistant Director in Chief of NSAA; and Maestro Andrew Sewell of the Wisconsin Chamber orchestra.
