Tour the museum's Main Building on your own from 9:00 AM to 5:00 PM daily.
Enjoy a guided tour of Vesterheim's Open Air Division of historic buildings
daily at 1:30 PM and on Friday and Saturday mornings at 10:30 AM.

The national museum and heritage center showcases the most comprehensive collection of authentic Norwegian American artifacts in the world. "USA Today" named Vesterheim one of "the great places in the nation to admire American folk art."

You are invited to tour Vesterheim free before, during, or after Sangerfest 2018. Individuals who are registered for Sangerfest and have a Sangerfest name tag will be admitted free from Wednesday (May 30) to Sunday (June 3). In addition, registered individuals will also receive a 10% discount at the museum store.

Museum hours are from 9 AM – 5 PM daily.

Open air division tours are conducted daily at 1:30 PM.

A gallery talk on Norwegian silver will be presented at the museum on Friday, June 1, at 11 AM and again at 1 PM. You are invited to bring a piece of jewelry and find out more about it.
