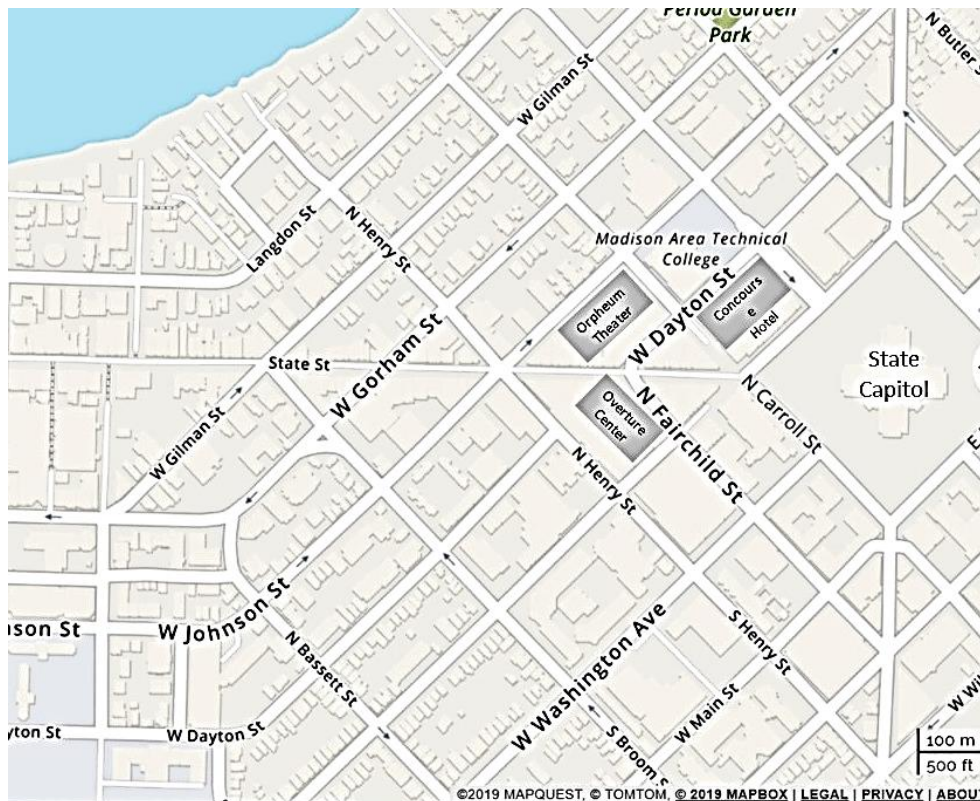


Downtown Madison Map Sangerfest 2020



Welcome to downtown Madison, Wisconsin. As you can see on the above map, all venues are within easy walking distance from the Concourse Hotel. The sidewalks are ramped, so it should ease some of the difficulty in you have trouble with mobility. If you should need the free shuttle service provided by the Concourse Hotel, it is best to make reservations in advance.

The Concourse Hotel has guest parking for a daily fee, and there is a parking ramp with hourly rates available kitty-corner to the hotel at N Carroll and Dayton Streets.

The Concourse Hotel is only ½ block away from the Capitol Square, which is a beautiful setting for strolling or sitting. The Wisconsin State Historical Society and the Wisconsin Veterans Museum are at the corner of State Street and the Capitol Square. The Madison Farmer's Market held each Saturday is worth the trip. The State Capitol building is open to the public—if you ask, you might find stone in the building that comes from your state. And did you know that Madison downtown streets are named after the 39 signers of the U.S. Constitution? (Although a few have since been renamed.)

A stroll along State Street is always an experience—filled with shops, restaurants and the usual (and unusual) Madison characters.
